## Program Description

One of the constant challenges of public school administration is staying current on school finance and the changes in education law affecting it. Administrators sometimes feel that they need a financial expert on speed dial.

To address this challenge, the Cooperative Council for Oklahoma School Administration (CCOSA), the Oklahoma Association of School Business Officials (OKASBO) and Vernon Florence Consulting (VFC) have developed a program to assist school districts with budgeting, financial planning, funding projections, OCAS coding and fund balance projecting. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC, through its executive staff, will provide the following types of financial assistance to Oklahoma school districts that choose to participate in this program:

- Consultation by email, telephone, or in person at a CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC office with executive staff members.
- Assistance with district document review: including preliminary estimate of needs, budget, state aid and financial accounting documents.
- Specialized training at a CCOSA office (no additional travel expense for the participating district) or at a mutually convenient location with the CCOSA/ OKASBO/VFC actual travel expense paid by the participating districts.

## **Participating School Districts**

Each participating school district may designate district administrators who are authorized to initiate requests for financial assistance from the CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC staff. Designated members should be active members in good standing of CCOSA or OKASBO. The purpose of this designation is to ensure that questions can be answered promptly and situations, that can be addressed appropriately by other administrators in the school district, are handled within that district.

It is CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC's desire to make its program of financial assistance avail-



able to every school district in our state that chooses to participate. The district may include additional school personnel in conference calls, on-site visits and training sessions. School districts participating in this program will receive additional financial assistance above and beyond individual member services. **Participating** school districts are encouraged to utilize the financial assistance program judiciously.

CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC's program will emphasize budgeting, financial planning, funding projections, OCAS coding and fund balance projecting. A complete list of services is provided on the back of this brochure. Additional events may be purchased at a discounted price. There may be some financial matters that arise that are not included on the provided list. CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC staff will be happy to recommend solutions for those financial events if they should occur.



CCOSA and OKASBO encourage school districts considering participation in this program to contemplate their district's needs to determine if this program offers them solutions. Any school district considering participation in the program is encouraged to visit with the CCOSA/OKASBO/VFC staff so that the district makes a reasonable and financially sound decision regarding its participation.
